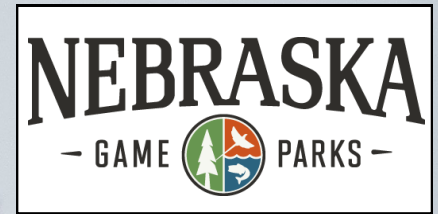




## Marsh Madness Ponca State Park March 28, 2020
