NEBRASKALAND Days Announces 2026 Viaero Summer Jam Concert Series Lineup

NORTH PLATTE, NE – NEBRASKALAND Days is proud to announce that **Zach Top** and **Treaty Oak Revival** will **Headline** for the **2026 Viaero Summer Jam Concert Series**, set for **Friday, June 26th** and **Saturday, June 27th** at the Wild West Arena in North Platte. “We couldn’t be more excited about the 2026 lineup,” said **Bob Lantis**,

we’ve got a mix of tradition, rising stars, and fan favorites that will make for an unforgettable weekend of live music in North Platte.”



On **Friday, June 26th**, fans will kick off the weekend with headliner **Treaty Oak Revival**, one of the hottest rising names in the Red Dirt and Americana music scene. Treaty Oak Revival is a Texas country rock band rooted in the heart of West Texas. Formed in 2019, the group features Sam Canty (lead vocals/acoustic guitar), Lance Vanley (rhythm guitar/harmonies), Jeremiah Vanley (lead guitar), Andrew Carey (bass), and Cody

Holloway (drums). With diverse musical backgrounds, they’ve crafted a unique sound that defies easy categorization. Blending the rich traditions of Texas Red Dirt country with influences from punk and southern rock, Treaty Oak Revival delivers a raw, refreshingly unpolished vibe. They draw inspiration from their roots and often incorporate storytelling into their songs. The band has gained recognition for their heartfelt lyrics and engaging live performances, capturing the essence of Texas music culture. Their latest single, “Happy Face,” along with their most recent album, “Have a Nice Day,” is available for streaming on all platforms.

They’ll be joined by **special guests 49 Winchester**. Hailing from the small mountain town of Castlewood, Virginia, 49 Winchester has quickly become one of the most exciting rising bands in Americana and country music. Blending the raw honesty of Appalachian roots with the grit of southern rock and the soul of classic country, the band has carved out a unique sound that resonates deeply with fans across the country. With relentless touring, high-energy live shows, and a growing global fan base, 49 Winchester has become one of Americana and country’s most exciting acts. Now with a decade under its belt, 49 Winchester’s fifth studio album, *Leavin’ This Holler*, showcases a matured sound with powerful songwriting, orchestral collaborations, and themes shaped by family and growth.

Also joining the lineup for Friday, June 27th is **The Wilder Blue**. Built around the keen storytelling voice of primary songwriter and frontman Zane Williams, Paul Eason's salient lead guitar, the imaginative tandem of drummer Lyndon Hughes and bassist Sean Rodriguez, and the striking, compelling mind of multi-instrumentalist Andy Rogers,



The Wilder Blue bring their signature blend of sharp storytelling, gripping five-part harmonies, and masterful arrangements that shift effortlessly from fun and lively to stirring and chill-inducing. The Texas-based five-piece has carved out a unique space in rock-influenced country with four self-written and self-produced albums. Their latest release, *Still in the Runnin'* (March 2025), has already earned Whiskey Riff's No. 2 spot on its "Top Albums of the Year (So Far)," cementing The Wilder Blue as one of the most exciting bands in country music today.

On **Saturday, June 27th**, the stage belongs to headliner **Zach Top**, a breakout star who is redefining modern traditional country. Hailed as "the future of country music" by *Billboard*, Zach Top is in the midst of a breakout year. Most recently, he was named 2025 New Male Artist of the Year at the 60th ACM Awards and earned his first #1 single at country radio with "I Never Lie." These accomplishments follow the release of Top's acclaimed debut album, *Cold Beer & Country Music*, which was produced by Carson Chamberlain and landed on several "Best of 2024" lists, including *Rolling Stone*, *Billboard* and *The New York Times*, who praises, "the music is airtight and fluent—a demonstration of vivid coloring within hard lines." Known for his "thrilling" (Holler) live performances, Top recently wrapped his sold-out "Cold Beer & Country Music" tour, which included his two-night headline debut at Nashville's historic Ryman Auditorium, and is currently on the road with Dierks Bentley. The CMA Award-nominee has also shared stages with notable artists such as Dwight Yoakam, Billy Strings, Alan Jackson and Lainey Wilson. Widely respected by his peers, Top recently collaborated with Strings for an exclusive Apple Music Nashville Sessions three-song EP, *Me & Billy*, which is available now. Raised in Sunnyside, WA, Top grew up on classic country music around the family farm. At the age of seven, he formed a bluegrass band with his siblings, which set the stage for his future musical ambitions.

Joining him as special guests are **Diamond Rio**. Originating as The Tennessee River Boys in the 80's, the band evolved into Diamond Rio in 1989. The following year, they signed with Arista Nashville, and in 1991, with the release of "Meet in The Middle," became the first country music group in history to reach No. 1 with a debut single. The band is also known for their multi-week chart-topper "How Your Love Makes Me Feel," crossover hit "One More Day," as well as timeless hits "Beautiful Mess," "Unbelievable," "I Believe," and many more. Amassing numerous accolades

throughout the years, the band is a member of the Grand Ole Opry, won six Vocal Group of the Year Awards (four CMA and two ACM), received fourteen Grammy nominations, and won a Grammy Award for their album, *The Reason*.

Leading off the evening on Saturday will be up-and-coming **Cole Goodwin**. The 24-year-old singer/songwriter Cole Goodwin has garnered attention for his strong, textured voice paired with his meaningful writing and return to old-school Country sound. The Pooler, Georgia, native burst on the scene in 2023 with the release of his original, self-produced EP *Soon Enough*. Last year, the up-and-coming artist released what are now fan-favorite songs including "When You Get Home," co-written with fellow Georgia Southern University alum Will Moseley, and "Catchin' On," written with songwriter Justin Dukes. Recently signed to Big Machine Records, more new music from Cole is expected throughout the year as he crisscrosses the country touring with various artists.



Tickets for the 2026 Viaero Summer Jam Concert Series will go on sale to the public on September 5th, at 11 am. Fans are encouraged to secure their tickets early, as both nights are expected to be in high demand.
